Acids and bases (pool chemicals)  
Aerosols (**no** empty cans)  
Asphalt and roofing tar  
Automotive fluids (**no** oil)  
Cleaners and polishes  
Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs  
Flammables (gasoline, starting fluids)  
Flea collars and sprays  
Fluorescent light bulbs  
Home repair products (glues, caulking)  
Household batteries  
Household cleaners  
Mercury and mercury containing items  
Oil based paint (**no** latex or acrylic)  
Paint thinners, solvents, varnishes  
Pesticides  
Photographic chemicals  
Prescription medication (no controlled substances, contact Dept. for details)\*  
Sharps  
Weed killers  
Wood preservatives

## Unacceptable HHW\*

Automotive batteries  
Commercial-generated waste  
Industrial-generated waste  
Empty containers  
Explosives and ammunition  
Latex or acrylic paint  
Motor oil  
Radioactive materials (smoke detectors)

## Unacceptable Electronics\*

Hair Dryers  
Curling Irons  
Handheld/Power Tools  
Blenders  
Any Freon Containing Item  
Kitchen Appliances  
Remote Controlled Items  
Fans

*\*contact the Dept. for proper disposal*

*Fuels (gasoline, kerosene, etc.) will not be accepted in unapproved containers (milk jugs, glass jars, etc.)*

*Sharps must be brought in approved plastic containers (bleach & laundry soap containers are acceptable). Do not use plastic baggies, glass jars, etc.*

*Usable latex paints can be donated to local organizations. Otherwise, dry paint by using absorbent material (cat litter, sand, etc.) and dispose in trash.*
